Standardized Dress Code

All clothes must be appropriately sized for the student.
Excessive baggy, torn or tattered clothing or clothes that cling to the body will not be permitted.

TOPS

- A. **Collared Golf Style Shirts**
 - Solid color
 - No more than two buttons may be unbuttoned at the neckline
 - Logo no bigger than a quarter
- B. **Sweatshirts, vests, sweaters**
 - Solid color
 - Pullovers only for sweatshirts
 - Sweaters may have buttons
 - No hoods or pouches
- C. **Any Seabrook Int. Spirit Shirt**
 - Can only be worn on Fridays
 - Includes any shirt from Art, Student Council, Cheer, Band, Choir, Orchestra, Athletic teams, school Spirit shirt sold by PTA

Tucking in of Shirrtails

Must be tucked in if longer than student's wrist
May not reveal stomach when arms are raised

Coats/Jackets/ Hoodies

Must be placed in student's locker during day.
Backpacks remain in lockers during the day

Jewelry

Wrist bands, leather or spiked jewelry are not permitted
Pierced jewelry is limited to ears
No sunglasses

Bottoms

- A. **Pants/Slacks**

School uniform style pants
Solid black, brown, grey, khaki or navy color
Pockets must be flat against fabric
Cotton/twill/chino material only
No jean, vinyl, leather or nylon material
- B. **Shorts**

Must meet the same requirements as slacks for color/material
May not come shorter than 4" from top of knee cap when standing
- C. **Jumpers, Skirts, Skorts**

Meet the same requirements as slacks for color/material
Bottom of hem must be no more than 2" above the knee

Shoes

Must be comfortable for walking/exercise
Enclosed heel or back strap over heel
Heels no taller than 2"
Shoes must be closed toe – safety issue in Science area

Socks/Tights

Solid color only
Must be matching pair

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All clothing must be in good repair.
