



Seabrook Intermediate Standardized Dress Code



Tops

- A. Collared Golf Style Shirts
 - Solid color
 - No more than two buttons may be unbuttoned at the neckline
 - Logo no bigger than a quarter
- B. Sweatshirts, vests, sweaters
 - Solid color
 - Pullovers only for sweatshirts
 - Sweaters may have buttons
 - No hoods or pouches
- C. Any Seabrook Intermediate Spirit Shirt or HS Feeder shirt
 - Can be worn any day of the week
Includes any shirt from school or HS
 - Spirit shirt sold by PTA, Art, Student Council, Cheer, Band, Choir, Orchestra, Athletics, Magnet Shirt, etc.

Tucking in of Shirrtails

- Must be tucked in if longer than student's wrist
- May not reveal stomach when arms are raised

Coats/Jackets/Hoodies

- Must be placed in student's locker during day.
- Backpacks remain in lockers during the day
 - Only string backpacks allowed during school day

Jewelry

- Wrist bands, leather or spiked jewelry
- are not permitted
- Pierced jewelry is limited to ears
- No sunglasses

Bottoms

- A. Jeans/Pants/Slacks/Capris
 - School uniform style pants or jeans in good repair - no holes, no skin showing
 - Solid Black, Brown, Khaki, or Navy color
 - Pockets must be flat against fabric
 - Jeans/Cotton/twill/chino material only
 - No vinyl, leather or nylon material
 - No tights, no sweat pants, no athletic pants
- B. Shorts
 - Must meet the same requirements as Slacks for color/material
 - May not come shorter than 4" from top of knee cap when standing
 - No athletic shorts
- C. Jumpers, Skirts, Skorts
 - Meet the same requirements as pants for color/material
 - Bottom of hem must be no more than 2" above the knee

Shoes

- Shoes must be closed toe
 - safety issue in Science Area
- Must be comfortable for walking/exercise
- Enclosed heel or back strap over heel
- Heels no taller than 2"

Socks/Tights (under skirts, dresses, or shorts)

- Solid color only
- Must be matching pair

All clothes must be appropriately sized for the student.
Excessive, baggy, torn or tattered clothing or clothes that cling to the body will not be permitted.
