Standardized Dress Code 2019-20

Tops

All

- Solid Color
- One small logo
- Any Seabrook Intermediate Shirt or CCISD HS shirt can be worn any day of the week.
- Sweatshirts and quarter zips must be pullover only. No hoods or pouches.
- Sweaters may have buttons

Shirrtails

- Must be tucked in if longer than the student wrist
- May not reveal stomach when arms are raised

Coats/Jackets/Hoodies

- Must be placed in student locker during the day
- Backpacks remain in locker during the day
 - Only string backpacks allowed during school day.

Jewelry

- Pierced jewelry is limited to ears
- No sunglasses

Hats/Caps/Hoods/Bandanas/Etc.:

- No non-religious head coverings inside the building

ID Badges

- Student ID Badges must be worn at all times
- Photo visible, undefaced

Bottoms

Jeans/Pants/Slacks/Capris/Overalls

- Solid colors
- Pants or Jeans – no skin showing
- Pockets must be flat against fabric
- Jeans/cotton/twill/chino material only
- No vinyl, leather or nylon material
- No sweatpants, athletic pants
- No sagging

Shorts/Overalls

- Must meet the same requirements as pants for color/material
- May not come shorter than 4" from top of knee cap when standing
- No athletic shorts

Jumpers/Skirts/Skort

- Meet the same requirements as pants for color/material
- Bottom of hem must be no more than 2" above the knee

Shoes

- Shoes must be close toe
 - Safety issue in Science Area
- Must be comfortable for walking/exercise
- Enclosed heel or back strap over heel
- Heels no taller than 2"
- No slippers, house shoes, shower shoes or flip flops

Leggings/Tights

- Solid color
- Covered by shorts, skirts or pants
- May not be worn as pants

All clothes must be appropriately sized for student. Excessive, baggy, torn or tattered clothing or clothes that cling to the body will not be permitted. Must be worn at the natural waist line.

All dress code issues, whether specifically stated here, are at the discretion of SIS administrators.
